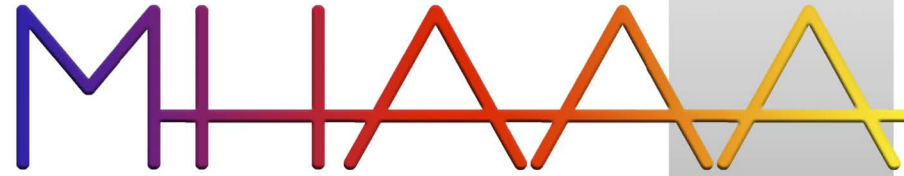

Mount Horeb Area Arts Association is a non-profit 501(c)(3) community and member supported organization. MHAAA produces the Annual Spring Art Tour and sponsors an annual High School Student Art Scholarship. Eligible student applicants attend high schools within the Spring Art Tour area; which extends North to Sauk City and Prairie du Sac, West to Ridgeway, East to West Middleton/Verona, and South to Blanchardville and New Glarus.
